Among them: *Public Health in Qajar Iran*; *Agriculture in Qajar Iran*; *The History of Theater in Iran*; *The Persian Gulf: A Political and Economic History of Five Port Cities*; *The Persian Gulf: The Rise of the Gulf Arabs*; Samuel Gottlieb Gmelin's *Travels Through Northern Persia 1770-1774*, and his most recent book, *A Social History of Sexual Relations in Iran*. Hasan Javadi is the author or translator of many books, including *Satire in Persian Literature*; *Persian Literary Influence on English Literature*; Forough Farrokhzad's *Another Birth and Other Poems*; and in Persian, *European Travelers in Iran*.
