Alliteration The repetition of the same consonant sounds and letters, often at the beginning of words. Antithesis The opposition of words/phrases or ideas that are put against each other in a sentence (e.g. 'More light and light, more dark and dark our woes' Act 3, Scene 5 Romeo and Juliet).
